The PhD Consortium of the Illinois International Accounting Symposium provides a forum for doctoral students to receive inspiration from their peers and discuss their research objectives with senior members of the community in the context of an established international conference.

The PhD Consortium will be held on Wednesday, June 3, 2026.

We invite PhD students to submit research papers or short proposals in any topic areas of accounting (e.g., international accounting, empirical capital markets research, financial analysis, corporate governance, financial accounting, managerial accounting, ESG, auditing, taxation, etc.) There is no submission fee.

Up to 25 PhD students will be invited to participate at the Consortium and present their work. An invitation will be based on the quality of the submitted work and the potential for contributing to the literature. Each PhD student will have 20 minutes for their presentation, including time for discussion and feedback. In addition to the student presentations, faculty-led workshops will cover a range of key topics, such as research methods and design, emerging research trends, guidance on preparing and submitting papers to journals, and professional development advice. These workshops aim to support students in refining their research and navigating their academic careers.
